

Inaugural Event Viewing

There is no doubt the inauguration will be a major draw for students and staff. Many teachers and schools have expressed interest in watching some of these events, both in terms of civic review and personal interest.

It is critical that schools primarily use Cable TV as the medium to view these events. If a large group plans to view the events in the library or gymnasium, most LCD projectors can be connected to the TV Tuner to increase viewership. If Cable TV access is not available in these locations, Internet viewing may be used sparingly.

Individual Internet viewing of the inaugural events is discouraged as too many concurrent connections will impact business operations throughout the district, including IFAS, eSIS, and GoalView to name a few. All end users will experience connections problems if multiple sites attempt to simultaneously stream (view on a computer) causing everyone to miss the events. YouTube will not be available for this event.

While every attempt was made to identify viewing options at each building/site, we know that some of the older sites will not have TVs for all locations, some cable may have been disconnected over time, and amplifiers may need to be revisited for signal strength. Nonetheless, Facilities/Capital Projects and Technology Services reviewed systems in preparation for the inaugural events and will make as many changes as possible to make viewing successful.
