Participants will learn new and innovative techniques through a variety of interactive workshops. Tutors, parents, teachers or anyone with an interest in improving the lives of our youth is welcome to attend.

**Participants can choose to attend three of the following workshops:**

**Tutoring 101** - New to tutoring? This workshop will explain the basics, including how to build relationships with and motivate students, structure sessions and set goals.

**Adventures in Reading for Elementary Students**- Tutors will learn meaningful tools and strategies for working with children for whom reading is a challenge.

**Boosting Middle School Reading Skills** - Participants will learn strategies to help middle-school students with reading comprehension and fluency.

**Shake, Shuffle, and Roll – Math Games For Elementary Students** - This workshop will teach tutors fun and creative games and activities they can use to take the anxiety out of math for elementary-school students.

**Shake, Shuffle and Roll for Middle School Students** – Explore engaging ways to teach math and discover new resources!

**Shoot for the Moon - Motivating Students** – Learn strategies to motivate and inspire students to want to learn!

**Beyond Gold Stars – Creative Behavior Management** - This session will teach tutors strategies for encouraging productive and positive behavior in students.

**Understanding Culture in the Tutoring Relationship** - This workshop will be an interactive exploration of culture and diversity issues with presenters from a variety of ethnic backgrounds, including Vietnamese and Oromo.

**Tutoring Mainstreamed Elem. and Middle-School ESL/ELL Students** - Participants will learn strategies to work effectively with elementary and middle-school English as a Second Language and English Language Learner students.

**Understanding Learning Disabilities** - The session will provide tutors with a basic understanding of learning disabilities and attention-deficit disorders, as well as how they can effectively present information to students.

**Engaging Kids with Different Learning Styles**— Explore theories and practical strategies to motivate and involve your students with different learning styles!

**Strategies for Struggling Readers**—Gain tools and methods to assist readers who are beginning and struggling with the mechanics of reading.

### **From Northbound I-5**

I5 N

Take the MLK Jr Way S Exit #157

Merge onto MLK Way S

Turn RIGHT on to Henderson

Turn LEFT on to Rainier Ave S

Travel for approx 3 miles

Turn Left on Graham

School in on the right side of the street
