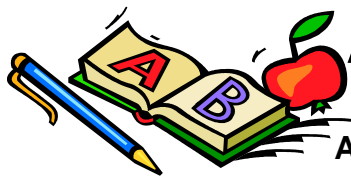

Recharge your tutoring skills at the Seattle Tutoring Coalition's All-City Tutor Training! This **FREE** training is designed to meet the core needs of all tutors. Participants will learn new and innovative techniques through a variety of interactive workshops. Tutors, parents, teachers or anyone with an interest in improving the lives of our youth is welcome to attend.

*Participants can choose to attend two of the following workshops:*

**Tutoring 101** - New to tutoring? Haven't had an orientation? Learn the basics, including how to build relationships with and motivate students, structure sessions and set goals.

**Adventures in Reading for Elementary Students** - This workshop will introduce participants to a child's world of reading, and will provide glimpses of steps children take in learning to read. Tutors will learn meaningful tools and strategies for working with children for whom reading is a challenge.

**Shake Shuffle and Roll – Math for Elementary Students** This workshop will teach tutors fun and creative games and activities they can use to take the anxiety out of math for elementary-school students.

**Beyond Gold Stars - Creative Behavior Management** – This workshop will help tutors understand why a student may have behavioral issues. Participants will learn strategies for encouraging productive and positive behavior in students.

**Shoot for the Moon – Motivating Your Student** – Learn strategies to motivate and inspire your student to want to learn!

**Understanding Culture in the Tutoring Relationship** – This workshop will be an exploration of culture and diversity issues and their impact on the tutoring relationship.

**Boosting Middle School Reading Skills** - Participants will learn strategies to help middle-school students with reading comprehension and fluency.

**Shake, Shuffle and Roll for Middle School Students** – Explore engaging ways to teach math and discover new resources!

Turn RIGHT at the light onto Swift Ave

### **From Northbound I-5**

I5 N

Take the MLK Jr Way S Exit #157

Merge onto MLK Way S

Turn RIGHT on to Henderson

Turn LEFT on to Rainier Ave S

Travel for approx 3 miles

Turn Left on Graham

School in on the right side of the street
