



Program Details

- The program went live on October 5, 2007, at www.qwest.com/onepercent.
- Qwest will donate one percent of a residential customer's bill amount to the public school district of the customer's choosing, involving no additional expense for the customer.
- Only residential accounts are eligible.
- To be eligible for the program, customers must sign-up for paperless billing + EFT.
- Customers will be able to select their school district during the registration process.
- Customers may designate any public school district in Qwest's 14-state service area to receive the one percent donation.
 - Customers must select a single school district to receive the donation. It will not be prorated or divided between more than one district, although customers will be able to change the district throughout the year if they desire.
 - Qwest's 14-state service area includes: Arizona; Colorado; Idaho; Iowa; Minnesota; Montana; Nebraska; New Mexico; North Dakota; Oregon; South Dakota; Utah; Washington; and Wyoming.

Until December 9 to Enroll:

- From launch until December 9, 2007 customers will enroll through our online chat reps. Hours of operation are: **Sunday** 11:30 AM - 8:00 PM Central, **Monday-Friday** 7:00 AM - 11:30 PM Central, **Saturday** 8:00 AM - 6:30 PM Central
- Starting December 9, 2007, customers will be able to enroll through their MyAccount page.

- Log onto www.qwest.com/onepercent. There will be a link to do this online beginning December 9, 2007. Until then, please establish a chat session with one of our reps during the hours listed above.

Additional Information

- Customers will not be able to use this contribution for their tax benefit as it comes out of Qwest's corporate giving budget.
- Contributions to the school districts will be mailed in the second and fourth quarters of 2008. Qwest will report the progress of the program at www.qwest.com/onepercent on a quarterly basis.
 - A customer's bill includes all five products before taxes (local, long distance, DTV, broadband and wireless).
 - Right now, Qwest plans to continue this program through 2008.
