Puget Sound Skills Center student leadership activities are for the purpose of giving students an opportunity to develop a sense of belonging, greater school pride, leadership skills, a sense of accomplishment and a commitment to one's community. Puget Sound Skills Center endorses encourages and supports leadership activities for students. In accordance with State guidelines for vocational education, a leadership component shall be integrated into each program curriculum.
